#### Who is Dave:

Dave Hingsburger works providing direct service to people with developmental disabilities. He is a consultant to self-advocate groups, parents, schools and agencies regarding a wide range of issues including sexuality, abuse and problematic behaviour. For six years he was the sex clinic coordinator at York Behaviour Management Services Sexuality Clinic in Richmond Hill, Ontario. As such he worked with people with developmental disabilities who engaged in inappropriate or deviant sexual behaviour. Since September of 1991, his involvement with the clinic has been as a consultant. He is now in private practice providing education and consultation for staff and agencies and counselling for people with disabilities.

Mr. Hingsburger is published widely in magazines, newspapers and journals on issues relating to disabilities. He is a frequent writer for "Mount: the voice of the disability nation "as well as other magazines by and for people with disabilities. Many of Dave's books are used in colleges and universities in courses related to developmental disabilities. Dave also is a contributing editor for Mental Health Aspects of Developmental Disabilities and is a consulting editor for Mental Retardation. He is a member of the national advisory council of the Sexual Information and Education Council of Canada. Mr. Hingsburger's groundbreaking work has been the subject of an hour long documentary on the Discovery Channel as well as the focus of a CBC "Moving ON" segment.

Dave has been the recipient of a number of awards including the lifetime achievement award from the Institute on Dual diagnosis, the Dana Sambour award presented by the Committee on Sexuality, the President's Award presented by the AAMR subcommittee on sexuality, the YAI achievement award presented by the Young Adult Institute and the Professional of the Year award presented by the Newmarket and District Association for Community Living.

Mr. Hingsburger lectures extensively. He has given keynote speeches at the national and international level. Educationally, Mr. Hingsburger earned his B.A., in psychology at the University of Victoria in British Columbia, and certificate in Human Relations from Ryerson in Toronto and his M.Ed. from the University of Toronto.
